

Employer Supervised Self Swab (ESSS)



- Firms would be required to conduct supervised self-swabs for persons who are required to undergo ART testing.
- Swabbing exercise must be supervised by a **trained ART supervisor** either at the **workplace or virtually** using digital tools such as video conferencing.

Obtain ART Kits



- **For Medically eligible workers**, employers to procure HSA approved test kits from pharmacies, supermarkets or from any of the suppliers listed at <https://go.gov.sg/bca-hsa-art-list>
- **For medically ineligible workers**, complete MI declaration to receive subsidised kits

Training ART Supervisors



- **Only trained ART supervisors may be deployed** to supervise workers for VoRT Testing. To send your employee for training, please visit <https://go.gov.sg/bcaa-art-training>

Uploading of Results



- Upon completion of testing, ART supervisors should upload the ART results for employees under their care.
- For “Ag+” or retested “Ag Invalid” individuals, results must be uploaded no later than 30 minutes after the ESSS
- For Ag- cases, results must be uploaded no later than 24 hours

Declaration for Medically Ineligible (MI) for vaccines



- Government will subsidise the costs for all their required tests until 31 December 2021.
- Employers are required to declare the status of personnel who are medically ineligible for COVID-19 vaccinations to arrange for the delivery of subsidised ART kits

- **Such individuals should be referred for confirmatory PCR test**
