



Sixteen Individuals, Organisations and Building Projects lauded at the SGBC-BCA Sustainability Leadership Awards 2017

Singapore, 13 September 2017 — The Winners of the SGBC-BCA Sustainability Leadership Awards 2017 were announced tonight, before a crowd of 650 local and foreign professionals from the built environment sector. Organised by the Singapore Green Building Council (SGBC) and the Building and Construction Authority (BCA), the Awards celebrate individuals, organisations, and project teams who have made excellent contributions, innovations, and achievements in the green building industry.

Besides the two categories from the inaugural Awards in 2016 which honour green building projects and green building organisations, this year's SGBC-BCA Sustainability Leadership Awards will also include awards given to exemplary green building individuals. The Green Building Individual Awards have been given out by BCA and SGBC since 2011, to commend individuals who have made significant contributions to the green building movement.

Announced during the SGBC's Gala Dinner 2017 at the Grand Copthorne Waterfront's Grand Ballroom, the Winners received their trophies from Guest-Of-Honour Mr Lawrence Wong, Minister for National Development and Second Minister for Finance. Winners of certain categories will go on to represent Singapore in the biennial World Green Building Council (WorldGBC) Asia Pacific Leadership in Green Building Awards that will be held in October 2018. "We hope that the Winners will be an inspiration to everyone in the building and construction industry, leading the way for sustainability and showing how Singapore can make an impact on the greater green building movement for the years to come", said Mr Tan Swee Yiow, President, Singapore Green Building Council.

The Awards is one of Singapore's leading accolade that recognises professionals and their organisations for their achievements in environmental sustainability in the built environment. A panel of 20 judges from the private and public sectors assessed the nominees based on rigorous selection criteria.

The Awards also raises awareness of green buildings to the public. Comprising both newer and existing building projects that are certified by the BCA Green Mark Scheme, the Winners of the Green Building Projects category exemplify Singapore's enduring commitment to the green building movement over the past decade.

BCA Chief Executive Officer, Mr Hugh Lim said, "I am glad to witness the exemplary contributions of Singapore's green building individuals, organisations and buildings, making their mark in the industry. As Singapore steadily advances towards its goal of greening 80 percent of our existing buildings by 2030, the Winners serve as shining examples of industry best practice, helping the built environment move towards greater sustainability."

During the SGBC Gala Dinner 2017, SGBC also announced two new programmes; the SGBC-BCA Zero Capital Partnership Scheme (ZCPS) for Lighting Retrofits, and the SGBC-BCA Green Facilities Management (FM) Accreditation Scheme. The SGBC-BCA ZCPS for Lighting Retrofits will help building owners improve the energy efficiency of lighting in their buildings and premises. The SGBC-BCA Green FM Accreditation scheme will enable the industry to build up a base of FM companies with sound credentials in operating and sustaining green buildings.
