BUILDING CONTROL ACT 1989 (CHAPTER 29)

BUILDING CONTROL (ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 49 of the Building Control Act 1989, the Minister for National Development makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Building Control (Environmental Sustainability) (Amendment) Regulations 2025 and come into operation on 2025.

Amendment of regulation 2

- **2.** In the Building Control (Environmental Sustainability) Regulations 2008 (G.N. No. S 199/2008) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations), in regulation 2
 - (a) delete ", unless the context otherwise requires"; and
 - (b) after "Code", insert
 - ""environmental sustainability score" or "ES score" has the meaning given by section 22FA of the Act;".

Amendment of regulation 4

- 3. In the principal Regulations, in regulation 4
 - (a) in the regulation heading, replace "Green Mark score" with "ES score"; and
 - (b) in paragraph (1)(a) and (b), replace "a Green Mark score" with "an ES score".

Miscellaneous amendment

4. In the principal Regulations, in the following provisions, replace "Green Mark score" wherever it appears with "ES score":

Regulation 4(2) and (3)

Regulation 6(1)(a)

Regulation 7

Regulation 8

Regulation 9(1).

Saving and transitional provision

5. Despite regulations 3 and 4, the regulations 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the principal Regulations as in force immediately before [date of commencement of SL] continue to apply to any building works in respect of which an application for planning permission is submitted to the competent authority under the Planning Act 1998 before that date.
