Safe Management Measures for Condominiums in Phase 2 (Heightened Alert) [From 10 August 2021 Onwards]

The Multi-Ministry Taskforce had announced on 6 August 2021, the calibrated easing of safe management measures in Phase 2 (Heightened Alert) starting from 10 August 2021.

2 Management Corporations (MCSTs) should note the following safe management measures (SMMs) and put in place measures to ensure compliance with these SMMs by their residents.

^{*} An individual is considered vaccinated if he/ she has been: a) fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the full regimen of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnatry, Moderna or WHO EUL vaccines, with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective, b) recovered from COVID-19, or c) has obtained a negative result on a pre-event test taken in the past 24 hours before the expected end of the event.

- 3 MCSTs are advised to make reference to the latest guideline and advisory issued by agencies on SMMs.
- 4 We seek MCSTs' cooperation to remain united and vigilant in the fight against COVID-19.
