PRODUCTIVITY SOLUTIONS GRANT FOR SMALL AND MEDIUM-SIZED ENTERPRISES

The Building and Construction Authority (BCA) launched the new tranche of the Productivity Solutions Grant (PSG) under BuildSG Transformation Fund (BTF) on 1 April 2023. The grant aims to support small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) keen on adopting pre-approved digital solutions, which enhance firms' productivity under the [Construction and Facilities Management Industry Digital Plan \(IDP\)](#).

2 Aligned to the Built Environment Industry Transformation Map (BE ITM), this Industry Digital Plan is also part of IMDA's SMEs Go Digital programme, designed to help SMEs in Singapore improve efficiency and effectiveness through adopting digital solutions. The pre-approved solutions supported by the PSG include digital platforms based on the Common Data Environment data standards, which will allow SMEs to plug into the Integrated Digital Delivery (IDD) ecosystem. More digital solutions will be introduced. There will be increased emphasis on training and capability building and SMEs can leverage the comprehensive training plans, including standard templates from solution providers, to support their digitalisation and staff training.

PSG Tranche 2 Funding Support

3 Eligible firms can apply for the PSG, which can co-fund up to 50% of the qualifying costs of adopting pre-approved digital solutions and they can make multiple applications across various solution categories, subject to a funding cap of \$30,000 per firm over 3 years until 31 March 2026.

Eligibility

- 4 Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria at the point of application¹:
- The applicant must be a registered business in Singapore
 - Have at least 30% local shareholding
 - Company's Group annual sales turnover of not more than \$100 million or staff strength of not more than 200 employees
 - Have its primary and/or secondary business activity in Construction and Facilities Management sub-sectors according to the Singapore Standard Industrial Classification Code (SSIC)
 - The applicant's purchase/subscription of the solution must be used in Singapore.
