

Media Statement on Glass Incident at Springleaf Tower

21 April 2015 – On 21 April 2015 at about 11am, BCA was informed by the Police that a glass panel had fallen off Springleaf Tower along Anson Road. BCA officers arrived on site and found that a glass panel on the exterior of the building had shattered and parts of the glass panel had fallen from about 10 metres above ground. No injury was reported.

The management corporation of the building has since cordoned off the area for public safety. BCA will also be ordering the management corporation to engage a Professional Engineer or glass specialist to investigate the cause of the incident and carry out checks to ensure that the existing glass panels and their fixtures are safe.
