**BOLD TO BE BALD**

- 30 BCA officers go bald for Hair for Hope 2016 raising more than \$27,000



**Singapore, 1 Oct 2016** – Ms Delfin Yeo was the only female among 30 officers from the Building and Construction Authority (BCA) who has made a bald statement to raise funds and awareness of childhood cancer. She lost a childhood friend who was diagnosed with leukaemia when she was seven years old. Realising that battling the cancer can be more trying for children, who might be confused over what is happening to their body, and losing people around her to cancer made her more determined to raise awareness for childhood cancer. Delfin was the first in BCA to suggest participating in Hair for Hope which then quickly draw interest from others who are keen to go bald for a good cause. It was the first time BCA is participating as a satellite partner for Hair for Hope. More than \$27,000 has been raised.
