#### **Leadership Commitment**

- Decide on the change in the workflow.
- Anticipate a possible downtime and potential delay in delivery at the start.
- Decide on a contingency plan, should it happened.







# People:-

## **Training Programme**

- Train all staff to be BIM ready, as most are still accustomed to AutoCad (2D), except for a selected few.
- Conducted in-house BIM courses on a fortnightly basis, over a couple of months.
- Conducted in-house briefing on the impending changes in the workflow and IFC SG.
- Always on a lookout for courses to upgrade and/or break new boundaries.




# People:-

#### **Internal Re-organization**

- Identify key staff to have the relevant skill sets to push our agenda.
- Identify key staff to kick start the re-organization.
- Identify the BIM Lead and BIM Ready Personnel.
- Identify Personnel from the AutoCAD Core Team to Upgrade to BIM Ready.
- Conduct regular in-house briefing, especially on the COP for Corenet X, to keep all staff updated with the changes and what office is putting in place, to support them.





#### **Process:-**

- Understand and internalize the new regulatory process (RABW New Regulatory Approval for Building Works) under CORENET X.
- Review of existing internal processes and standard operation procedure (SOP) to keep up with the impending change.
- Participate and implement experiences and know how gained from CORENET X sandbox and;
- Participate in "Live Submission", etc.



# **Technology:-**

- Build up BIM and IFC-SG capability
- Set-up Internal BIM templates to enhance productivity
- Mapping of IFC-SG, etc.



- ✓ Tested application using a completed project to understand the workflow and IFC-SG compatibility.






